The Guardian Angels' Funds of the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation consist of an endowment fund and an expendable grants fund. Small grants are made to meet the immediate and critical needs of local men that are not met by traditional funding sources.

Members of the Guardian Angels share a strong commitment to continually increasing the endowment so men can lead lives filled with promise and opportunity. The beauty of the Funds is that there is no ending to the good that they provide.

Currently, we are accepting gifts of \$500 for founding memberships. Men of all professions are encouraged to participate and contribute to this worthy effort of "men helping men". There will also be opportunities to serve on working committees and the advisory board. The Guardian Angels program is long overdue and we look forward to reaching out and providing support to men who need someone to care for them..

★ Men Helping Men: How it works

Members of the Guardian Angels and generous corporate donors contribute to the endowed fund. Grant expenditures are made from monies available each year from the expendable fund and income from the endowed fund. The endowed fund will grow in perpetuity, providing more and more grant making monies in the years to come.

Upon receipt, an application is reviewed by the Guardian Angels' Grants Committee and funds are typically made available within 48 hours. Funds are paid directly to the vendors of requested services and needs.


Grant recipients are asked to help someone else in the future through a "Pay-It-Forward" principle.
