A \$500 scholarship is available for the 2017-2018 academic year.

Criteria:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of a Manhattan area high school including: Manhattan High School, Rock Creek High School, Riley County High School, Flint Hills Christian School, or Blue Valley High School
- Applicant must attend a Manhattan area school in the Fall of 2017, including: Kansas State University, Manhattan Christian College, or Manhattan Area Technical College.
- Applicant must have demonstrated outstanding leadership in high school and community-related activities.
- Applicant must plan to further pursue leadership roles in his/her college career at a Manhattan area university, college or technical school.
