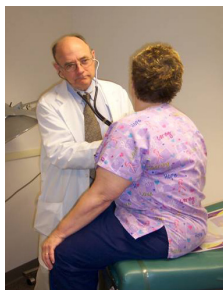


## Greater Manhattan Community Foundation

Founded in 2005 the Flint Hills Community Clinic is committed to understanding and serving the health and wellness needs of the medically underserved in our community by providing quality, compassionate and personalized care. Early in 2007 Reverend Jim Reed, a FHCC board member and advocate, announced his retirement as senior minister for the First United Methodist Church. As a gift to him from his congregation, an endowment was established in Jim's name to support the mission of the clinic. As the endowment investments grow the earnings will be used to support the clinic's operating expenses as well as subsidize medications for clients.

### Camp STARS



*(Strength, Teamwork, Attitude, Relationships, Self-Esteem)*

For many kids, going to camp is a routine part of their summer. But, for some kids, like the ones who suffer from serious emotional disturbances (SED), this typical summer activity isn't so routine.



Thanks to Pawnee Mental Health, 180 children diagnosed with SED were able to spend August 4-6 at *Camp STARS*, located at Rock Springs Ranch. During camp activities the youth learned about personal strength, self-esteem, coping skills, and active listening skills. They were then led in activities to apply what they had struggled with and learned to "real life" challenges that they face.

Camp Stars is the only camp of this type in our area. It benefits the community by reducing aggressive behavior in SED children as well as improving life skills.
