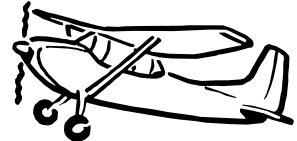

Re: Request for Proposals – Don Dodge Youth & Aviation Fund



The Greater Manhattan Community Foundation is pleased to accept grant applications from non-profit tax-exempt organization in the greater Manhattan area that support **youth aviation projects and/or programs**.

Approximately \$9,400 is available from the Community Foundation's Don Dodge Fund for the purpose of supporting youth and aviation programs. Mr. Dodge was an advocate of aviation programs and especially wanted to support youth enrichment activities in the area of airplane mechanics.

If you have an aviation project that you are seeking funding for, we invite you to send a proposal for our consideration. The proposal should identify a contact person and include a narrative explaining the project purpose, timeline, budget and population served. We generally do not fund staff time or other general operational expenses.

Proposals may be submitted by email, mail, or in person, but must be received by our office by 3:00 p.m., Monday, April 19, 2010. All proposals will be reviewed by our Grants Committee and final approval will be determined by the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees for Greater Manhattan Community Foundation no later than June 17th. You will be notified within one week of their decision as to the outcome of your proposal
