# Letter from our Board Chairman, Neil Horton

2014 was a phenomenal year for the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation. Many new records were set including Total Assets of \$55.7 Million and Grants & Programs for the community at \$2.2 Million. We are ahead of schedule in our six-year \$600,000 GROW II challenge grant from the Kansas Health Foundation, earning 76.1% of our match goal in just four years. The Foundation continued to partner with the Caroline Peine Foundation and our Yes Fund Advisory Board in support of the YES! Fund Campaign. And our GROW Green Match Day in May raised more than \$225,000 for 32 Funds. Our community support continued to diversify with the establishment of twenty-five new funds in 2014.



Our service to the community is wide ranging, enabling a variety of programs that support youth,

the elderly, arts, education, social services and many others. The Foundation remained committed to our mission of "Building relationships between donors and community needs." This past year the Foundation helped the start-up of a new fund, The Guardian Angels, established by caring men in our community who were inspired by the Fairy Godmothers Fund. As of December 2014 their membership has grown to 95 men, with over \$36,600 of funds raised and grants totaling almost \$12,500 to 36 recipients. We also added an affiliated foundation from the community of Marysville.

These results are possible due to the efforts of our dedicated staff -- Vern Henricks-President; Elaine Dhuyvetter-Vice President of Marketing and Programs; and Marla Brandon-Vice President of Finance -- who excel in their daily commitment to the promotional and operational functions of the Foundation.

Finally, the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation depends on and is appreciative of the support of its many volunteers, trustees, board members and generous donors. All of you, working together, ensure success in our goal of building better communities.

# **Types of Funds**

The Community Foundation offers a variety of fund options to help you meet your philanthropic goals. From donor-advised funds (where you engage in active grantmaking recommendations) to unrestricted funds (which rely on the Foundation's knowledge of community needs for grantmaking decisions), our funds allow you to choose your level of participation.

You can establish a fund using cash, securities, closely-held stock, mutual fund shares, real estate, business interests (limited partnership shares, LLCs, etc.) and many other types of assets.

### **Donor Advised Funds**

Donor Advised Funds are charitable funds for those seeking active involvement in grantmaking. Fund holders – and their successors, if desired – advise or recommend grants from their fund to support nonprofit organizations. Fund holders work with GMCF staff to create a lasting, impactful philanthropic legacy.

### **Field of Interest Funds**

Field of Interest Funds are funds that have been established by the Community Foundation for granting to a broad area of interest rather than a single nonprofit organization in a particular field. Field of Interest Funds are also endowed funds, meaning that they will continue to make annual grants in perpetuity.

### Scholarship Funds

Scholarship funds support those who want to pursue education, whether they're high school graduates pursuing a college degree, young athletes seeking assistance with additional training or nontraditional students who are returning to the work force. Fund holders work with Foundation staff to devise selection criteria.

### Supporting Organizations

Supporting organizations are separate legal entities that are affiliated with the Community Foundation. They are established with their own boards, grantmaking identities, and governance structures. Supporting organizations enjoy public charity status and the professional services of the foundation which includes staff and administrative support.

### **Unrestricted General Endowment Funds**

Fund holders can support community needs by providing unrestricted support. You can create a named endowed fund where the foundation's board of directors will use the funds to address changing community needs. Unrestricted general endowed funds provide support for the Grants for Greater Manhattan and YIC Grants programs.

### **Designated Funds**

You may wish to support a specific nonprofit organization. Once the fund is established, grants are made annually to the organization(s). Foundation staff monitor the organization to honor your philanthropic intentions. With a designated fund at the Community Foundation, you receive professional management and grant monitoring. Nonprofit Organizations can establish endowment funds to provide financial support to their organization in perpetuity and be a conduit for planned gifts. Designated Funds may also be established to benefit capital campaigns.

### **ESTABLISHING A CHARITABLE FUND IS SIMPLE!**

The GMCF staff will help you every step of the way. You may also involve your financial planner in the process.

- 1. Select the type of fund that best supports your charitable goals.
- 2. Complete a simple fund agreement.
- 3. Designate current fund advisors such as yourself and spouse, and successor advisors such as your children.
- 4. Make an establishing gift.
- 5. Receive a tax deduction at the time the fund is established and when additional contributions are made to the fund.

Once your fund is established, you may recommend distributions from it to charities locally or throughout the USA.

### PROFESSIONAL **ADVISOR PROGRAM**

As their Edward Jones Financial Advisor, Matt Paquette knows Leland and Janice well. "These people are two of the most giving individuals I know, said Matt, "so when they were selling land, a taxable event, I knew that charitable giving was something that would interest them." Matt was able to help the Reitz's meet their tax and charitable goals by setting up a donor advised fund with the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation, while maintaining his role as manager of these funds.

The Reitz Family Fund was the first fund to be established with a partnership between GMCF and an outside advisor. Since then, a program has been developed to allow professional advisors and their clients the opportunity to utilize the foundation's charitable giving expertise while maintaining their client/ advisor relationship.



### **Reitz Family Fund**

Leland Reitz grew up and established his life-long career as a doctor in Manhattan, Kansas. After returning from the military, he and his wife, Janice, raised two boys here, who now live and work outside of the Manhattan area. In 2006, Dr. Leland & Janice Reitz established the Reitz Family Fund to provide support to the Manhattan community. "We feel blessed each day." said Janice, "Life has been good to us in this community, and it is important to give back." Through this donor advised fund Leland & Janice are actively involved in grantmaking by advising or recommending grants to support nonprofit organizations. "The arts - music, theatre, and dance, are important to us," stated Leland, "but we also look at other area agencies who have a big impact in our community and rely on local funding." Janice and Leland like to help lots of different nonprofits so they review their choices and make decisions each year. 


