# **Letter from the President**



The Greater Manhattan Community Foundation has completed another outstanding year. We came very close to a new benchmark when we distributed just under \$1,000,000 in grants through a variety of funds to improve the greater Manhattan region. The Foundation continued to work with the Caroline Peine Foundation and the YES! Fund Advisory Board to assure that the many youth programs it supports were funded again this year. After two years, we have collected 44.71% toward a six-year \$600,000 GROW II match grant challenge from the Kansas Health Foundation. In addition, we added thirteen new funds in 2012 bringing our assets at the end of the year to \$36,949,474.

The variety of programs that the Foundation supports is impressive. We have programs for youth, the elderly, the arts, education, social services and many more. The Foundation mission is to improve the quality of our communities by connecting donors to needs they care about. We are not here to be self-serving

but rather to facilitate in a variety of ways to help other organizations become stronger. In a few cases, the Foundation has been used to foster new ideas such as the Fairy Godmothers' Fund or to make sure that the YES! Fund continued to serve our community after the McCormick Foundation chose to stop its support.

We were disappointed when we had to wish Liz Workman farewell. Liz led the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation to another level of professionalism. We wish Liz the best on her move to Wichita with her husband. At the same time, we welcomed a familiar face to many of you, Vern Henricks, to replace Liz as the Executive Director/CEO. Thanks to the hard work of the Executive Board we hardly missed a beat. We also added Marla Brandon to the staff as our Finance Manager. Both Marla and Vern bring to the Foundation many years of experience and service to our community. Along with Elaine Dhuyvetter, Vice President Marketing and Programs, we are very fortunate to have a strong, dedicated and professional staff.

I want to thank our donors, friends, trustees, Executive Board and staff for their work and support this year. An organization like the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation cannot survive without the support of its many volunteers, generous donors and a strong staff. Because of them, the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation is succeeding in building better communities.

# **Shepherd's Crossing**

Unfortunately, some people in our community deny themselves important medications because they must spend money on rent, utility bills, and groceries. Since 2006, Shepherd's Crossing has received \$23,700 in grants from GMCF to help cover the cost of prescription medications for clients who are either uninsured or underinsured.

#### **UFM Community Learning Center**

UFM Community Learning Center is a non-profit campus and community education program serving KSU, the Manhattan area and communities across Kansas. UFM provides opportunities for lifelong learning and personal development. GMCF is proud to have supported UFM since 2003 with grants totaling \$13,481.

## **Riley County Community Corrections**

Riley County Community Corrections serves offenders placed on intensive supervision by the District Court as a result of felony convictions. **GMCF** has provided \$7,000 in grant funding since 2011 to provide much needed mental health & psychological evaluations, mental health medication evaluations, and prescription assistance for offenders on felony supervision. The goal of this program is to lessen the number of repeat offenders and increase public safety.

# Flint Hills Summer Fun Camp



Flint Hills Summer Fun Camp is an affiliated program of USD 383, organized and facilitated by parents from the Flint Hills Autism Parent Support Network. Since it began in 2010, the camp has received grants totaling \$14,115 from GMCF to support the "Afternoon Adventures" component of their camp. Afternoon Adventures activities promote health, wellness, socialization, sportsmanship, and leadership.

# **Manhattan Arts Center**

The Manhattan Arts Center (MAC) offers live theatre and music, art galleries, a variety of children's programs, classes for all ages, and a number of outreach activities. Since 2004, MAC has been awarded \$21,289 in grants from GMCF to provide quality programs to our community.



# **Flint Hills Community Clinic**

The Flint Hills Community Clinic (FHCC) provides acute non-emergent and ongoing primary care to uninsured residents of Riley County free of charge. Since opening in 2005, the FHCC has provided more than 10,200 free healthcare appointments to over 2,500 uninsured area residents. GMCF is pleased to have supported FHCC since 2005 with grants totaling \$17,500.



# First Time Grant Recipients in 2012

**Project EXCELL** 

Project EXCELL (Extending College Education for Lifelong Learning) provides personal enrichment and life skill classes to students and adults 18 years and older with developmental disabilities. This program provides opportunities for students who may not otherwise be able to participate in a college environment. EXCELL offers Saturday morning classes on the K-State campus in fall and spring semesters. In 2012 Project EXCELL received its first grant from GMCF in the amount of \$1,200 to assist with classroom supplies.

# KSU Golf Course Management & Research Foundation

First Tee of Manhattan is a division of the KSU Golf Course Management & Research Foundation. The program impacts the lives of local youth ages 5-17 by providing educational programs that build character, instill life-enhancing values and promote healthy choices through the game of golf. In 2012, GMCF awarded the program \$3,500 in grant dollars for golf equipment to help accommodate the increasing number of youth participants in the First Tee summer program.

#### Flint Hills Breadbasket

In both 2011 and 2012 a GMCF grant provided perishable food items for individuals in the community who had no food in their homes or the means to purchase any. Since 2006, GMCF has awarded the Flint Hills Breadbasket \$18,000 in grant funding.

## **SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION - Community Foundation of the Flint Hills**

A supporting organization is a separate legal entity, with its own board, its own bylaws, etc. However, it enjoys the status of a public charity due to its close connection with The Community Foundation, a connection that is similar to a subsidiary of a corporation. The Community Foundation elects the board of directors of the supporting organization. As such, it may be said that a supporting organization operates under the Community Foundation's "umbrella."

Through a supporting organization, donors receive the benefits and services of the Foundation while maintaining a separate board of directors that manages the organizations's grantmaking, investments and other functions.

In 2011, the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation announced it's first supporting organization - *the Community Foundation of the Flint Hills (CFFH)*. The purpose of this fund is to provide general support for our community and was started with a gift from Jack and Joann Goldstein totaling \$20.7 million. In 2012 the CFFH made grants totaling \$165,000 with a major portion of that providing support to McCain Auditorium and K-State University Golf Course Management and Research Foundation.



In 2011, GMCF received a \$600,000 matching grant from the Kansas Health Foundation's Giving Resources to our World Chapter Two (GROW II) Healthy Kansas initiative. Over this six year program, new gifts to endowed funds at GMCF will be matched up to the \$600,000 award according to a two-tiered matching ratio. Some gifts will be matched at the rate of 1-to-2, or \$1 match for every \$2 of new gifts and some gifts will be matched at the rate of 1-to-4, or \$1 of match for every \$4 of new gifts. # Manhattan Royal Family **Kids Camp**

Manhattan Royal Family Kids Camp provides a one week camp free of charge for foster children ages 7 - 11 from Manhattan and surrounding counties. 


